The European Commission's Directorate General for Climate Action (CLIMA) and the European Maritime Safety Agency (EMSA) are pleased to invite you to the *Second webinar on the extension of the EU Emission Trading Scheme (ETS) to the maritime transport sector*, that will take place on **24** November 2023 via Webex.

In the context of the 'Fit for 55' legislative package, the European Union recently adopted a revision of the EU ETS Directive, which will extend the EU ETS to maritime transport with a view to support the decarbonisation of the sector in line with the objectives of the European Green Deal.

As a follow-up to a first webinar organised on 22 September 2023 (the recordings are available at the following link: <u>ETS Webinar</u>), the European Commission and EMSA would like to present further developments, namely on secondary legislation on maritime MRV and ETS, and on key changes being implemented in THETIS MRV, the dedicated IT system for compliance with MRV obligations.
