Subject : Training Certificates That Are Not Required To Be Issued In Accordance With The STCW Convention.

All Turkish Certificates of Competency (CoC) issued to masters and officers since 1st January 2017 have been issued in accordance with the regulations of STCW Convention, as amended (STCW 2010 Manila Amendments).

Masters and Officers are required by STCW to receive certain training to qualify for their CoCs. These training requirements and competencies are covered in tables A-II/1, A-II/2, A-III/1 and A-III/2 of the STCW Code. The possession of a CoC without limitations will provide sufficient evidence the training requirements have been met. Accordingly, no Certificates of Proficiency are issued for the following proficiencies:

- Automatic Radar Plotting Aids (ARPA),
- Radar Observation And Plotting,
- Bridge Resource Management (BRM),
- Engine Resource Management (ERM),
- Electronic Chart Display and Information System (ECDIS)
- · Leadership and Teamworking Skills.
